Regular Meeting Held February 4, 2013

Mayor Seibold called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. in the City Commission Chamber at the Community Center and led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

2013-13. No public comment was received.

2013-14. Commissioner Dills reported the pond hockey tournament on January 26-27 was well attended and enjoyed good weather for the event. He questioned whether any further action was needed on the St. Stephen's dumpster issue. City Manager Donovan indicated the Public Works Department was still working on finalizing the issue and would report to the City Commission soon.

Commissioner Johnson thanked the Public Works Department for keeping the sidewalks and streets clear during the recent snowy weather. She also congratulated the Kent District Library on its designation as a "Star Library" by the Library Journal Index of Public Library Service for the third year in a row.

Mayor Seibold also thanked the Public Works Department for their work over the last week plowing and salting the roads. She noted the roads in East Grand Rapids were always noticeably better than other areas.

2013-15. City Clerk Brower demonstrated the features of the City's new website and answered questions from the City Commission. The Commissioners thanked the employees who worked on the new site for all their work in making the site so user friendly and appealing.
