Covid-19 Pool Policies and Procedures

We are excited to welcome you back to the EGR HS Pool.
Please wear your mask while entering the building and in shared spaces.
 We will provide on deck storage for your mask while you are in the water.

- Swimmers will enter through exterior door #27 off of Wealthy St.
- Check in with staff in the pool lobby. Swimmers will be asked to self screen at home. will need to confirm they are symptom free and that they have not been in contact with a person with Covid-18 before swimming.
- Staff will check in swimmers and verify pool membership, **no drop in swimming visits are permitted at this time.**
- 10 lanes will be available for swimming. We will have a max of two swimmers per lane. Families will be encouraged to share a lane. Lanes will be available on a first come first swim process. You might arrive at the pool and lanes may already be filled.
- Swimmers will be assigned a locker to use in the locker room. It will be strongly encouraged that locker rooms are used for showering and changing only - extended time (drying hair, etc. is discouraged). All patrons will be out of the locker room no later than 15min following their swim.
- Upon the completion of your swim you will be asked to exit the locker rooms to the North hallway. Swimmers are encouraged to check out with the staff in the pool lobby.

Policy and directional flow information will be available at the pool and online.

As always, our goal is to offer our patrons a safe and enjoyable swimming experience. We continue to work with the Kent County Health Department and executive orders from our State and National leaders. This may require us to modify our Covid-19 Pool Policies and Procedures.

Inclement Weather Policy:

If the East Grand Rapids Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, both pools will be closed. We will close in the event of a tornado watch or warning, or a power outage lasting longer than 30 minutes.

Pool Closures and Changes:

Unexpected pool closures may occur due to pool contamination and/or mechanical failure.
