

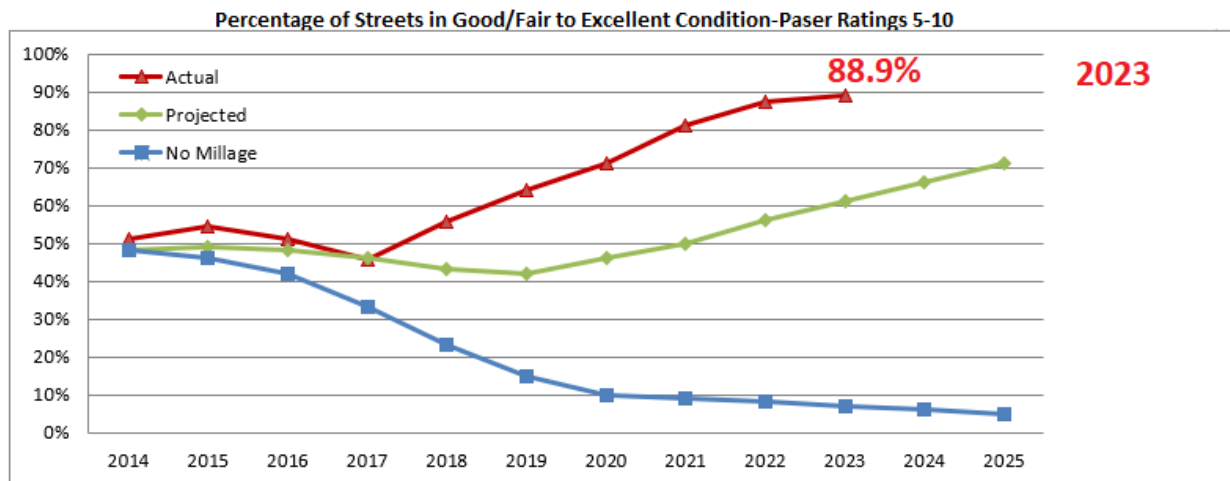


## 2023 Construction Recap

The EGR Public Works Department is committed to improving the approximate 50 miles of streets and 80 miles of sidewalks in the community. Thanks to a voter-approved millage, Public Works has successfully maintained and improved city street surface conditions since 2015.

City infrastructure enhancements continued in 2023, which resulted in PASER ratings of 88.9% of City streets rated as fair-excellent. This latest pavement condition rating is well above the projected 56%. The 2023 ratings demonstrate tax dollars are critical to the success to street and sidewalk improvements.

The graph below details the 2023 PASER ratings:



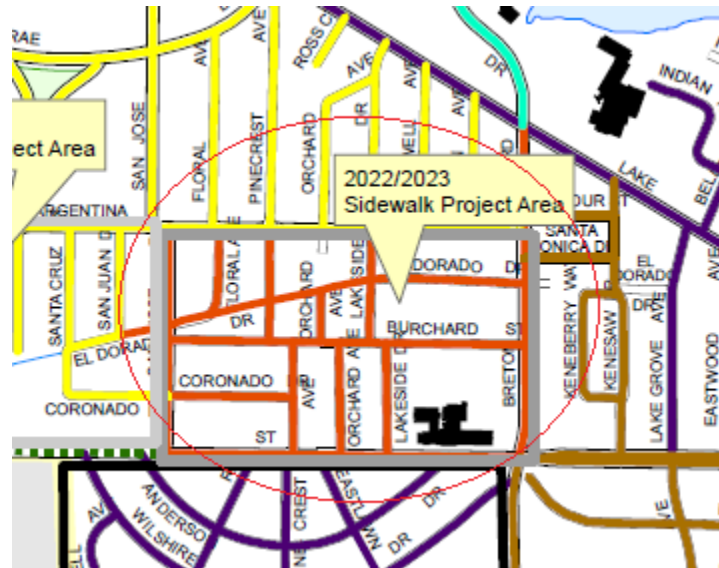
Thanks to the 2015 millage and water and sewer rate investments, the city has accomplished the following in the 2023 construction season:

### Street Construction:

- Mill and overlay: 2.92 miles
- Cape seal: 2.94 miles
- Total: 5.86 miles
- Investment total: \$1,608,500

## Sidewalk Rehabilitation and Replacement Program:

- The city utilized \$150,000 of the 2015 streets and sidewalk millage dollars to rehabilitate and replace City sidewalks in targeted areas
- In 2023, the targeted area was Argentina Drive east from San Jose Drive to Breton Road, south to Hall Street and west to San Jose Drive
- 4,642 feet of sidewalk trip hazards were removed
- 1,377 feet of sidewalk was replaced
- The city also replaced sidewalk throughout the community based on reported concerns that meet rehabilitation or replacement criteria



## Utility Infrastructure Improvements:

### Water Main Projects

- Rehabilitation of 2,709 feet and replacement of 900 feet (entire system stretches approximately 53 miles)
- 1.3% moving from level 5 rating to level 1 rating (PACP Asset Management Rating)
- Investment total: \$513,000

### Sanitary Sewer Projects

- Rehabilitation of 9,068 feet (entire system comprised of approximately 42 miles)
- 4.1% system improvement from level 5 rating to level 1 rating (PACP Asset Management Rating)
- Investment total: \$415,500

### Storm Sewer Projects

- Replaced of 75 feet-Lakeside Drive Large Diameter Culvert-Between Reeds and Fisk Lakes (entire system comprised of approximately 39 miles)
- .03% system improvement from level 5 rating to level 1 rating (PACP Asset Management Rating)
- Investment total: \$250,000

As we wrap up 2023, the EGR Public Works is reviewing asset ratings across utility infrastructure and funding levels so it can finalize projects for 2024.

The city is committed to informing residents, businesses, and visitors of construction projects. Notices are provided to those directly impacted by construction work before it begins.
